Sustainable CAP Overview

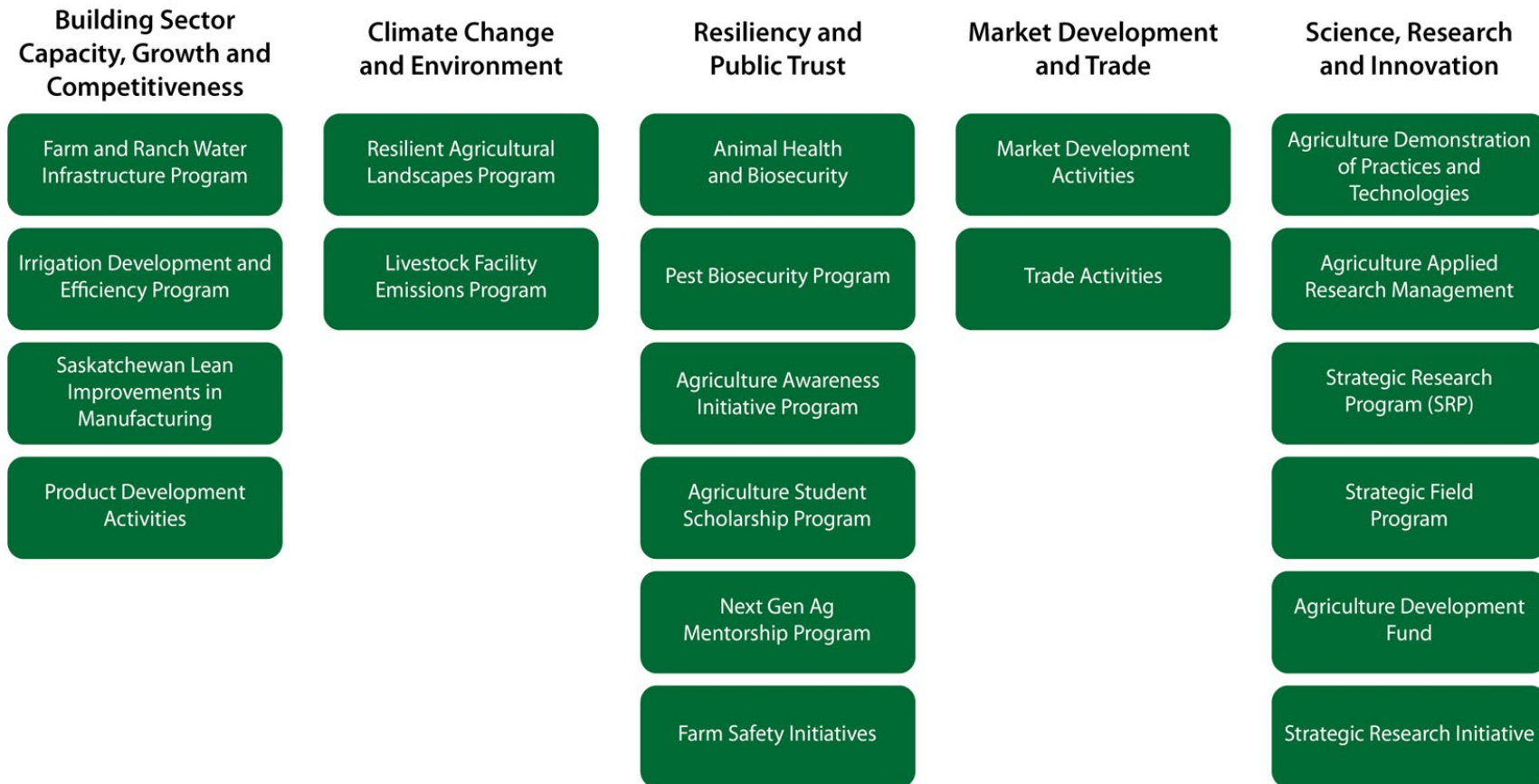
- Sustainable CAP aims to strengthen and grow Canada's agriculture and agri-food sector. This federal-provincial-territorial partnership includes a \$3.5 billion over five-year (2023-2028) investment in strategic initiatives as well as funding for Business Risk Management programs.

Sustainable CAP is a \$485M investment into Saskatchewan over five years (2023-2028) to continue to help the sector innovate, grow and prosper.

Federal-provincial-territorial investment is cost-shared on a 60:40 basis.

The Guelph Statement establishes the vision, guiding principles and priorities for Sustainable CAP.

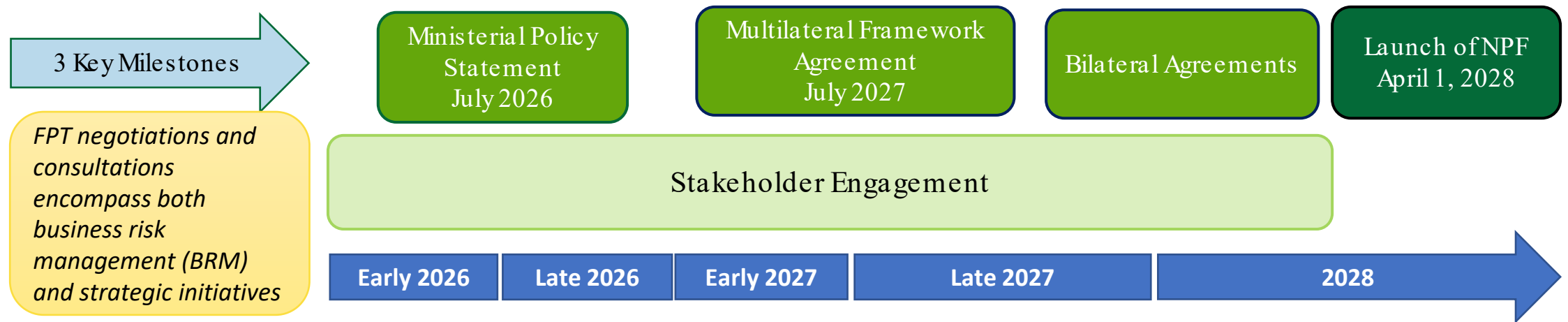


